Qualifications

- Minimum Age Requirement: 14 years
- G2 class licenses is an asset (for one specific station)
- Experience working with young children in a group setting is preferred
- Available to work all 18 days of the fair with the exception of scheduled days off
- Available to work flexible hours, evenings and weekends
- Able to attend Mandatory Orientation Session
- Must be comfortable working in the presences of animals and barnyard smells
- Ability to engage positively with children and their caregivers
- Required to dress in appropriate uniform

Application Process:

Applicants will be shortlisted for participation in the next step based on a review of each applicant assessing the likelihood of fit for the roles for which we are recruiting.
