The program is funded by the Ministry of Labour, Immigration, Training and Skills Development (MLITSD), and leverages a proven recruitment method connecting businesses with well-qualified candidates who are on the autism spectrum or have developmental disabilities.

Here is what you will do:

- Scan and validate admission tickets
- Ensure guests have produced appropriate ticket/pass to enter
- Offer and provide hand-stamp to guests for re-entry
- Control the flow of people entering and exiting their assigned gate
- Identify and escalate situations requiring supervisor's attention
- Answer basic questions from guests regarding programming, attractions, facilities and services

Qualifications

- Minimum Age Requirement: 16 years
- Available to work all 18 days of the fair (August 16 - September 2, 2024)
- Available to work flexible hours, evenings and weekends
- Able to attend Mandatory Orientation Session
- Ability to stand or be stationary for extended periods of time
- Ability to work outdoors for extended periods and in all weather conditions (sun, heat, wind, cold, rain) • Attention to detail, punctuality, professional demeanour
- Required to dress in appropriate uniform

Application Process:

The first step in the recruitment process is for interested candidates to apply to the role with Jake's House, by emailing your resume to jobs@jakeshouse.ca , with the title of the job in the subject line. Applicants will be shortlisted for participation in the next step based on a review of each applicant assessing the likelihood of fit for the roles for which we are recruiting.
