



JAKE'S HOUSE EMPLOYMENT TRAINING PROGRAM

Jake's House Employment Training Program is an innovative, adaptable program that supports the integration of individuals aged 16+ years with autism or a developmental disability, into the workforce. The program is funded by the Ministry of Labour, Immigration, Training and Skills Development (MLITSD), and leverages a proven recruitment method connecting businesses with well-qualified candidates who are on the autism spectrum or have developmental disabilities.

JOB TITLE: CASUAL CLEANER

Company: Exhibition Place- Canadian National Exhibition

Type of Role: Temporary- August 5th to September 13th

Location: Toronto

Overview: Reporting to the Facility Co-ordination team, the Casual Cleaner (Fixed Term) will perform a variety of duties to keep Exhibition Place clean and sanitary throughout the Canadian National Exhibition.

Successful candidates may be considered for future casual cleaning work opportunities dependent on Exhibition Place needs, with consideration being given to employee work and attendance record during this work assignment.

Here is what you will do:

- Clean and sanitize washrooms, including washing floors, toilets, mirrors, countertops, fixtures, removing waste and ensuring washrooms are well stocked with paper products.
- Indoor sweeping and light mopping of floor areas.
- Maintain cleanliness of Enercare Centre and/or outside overnight on Exhibition Place grounds, including sweeping, raking, picking up and removal of garbage and recycling.
- Maintain, replenish cleaning products and supplies.
- Inspect equipment prior to each shift and report any deficiencies (if assigned to drive).
- Complete and maintain work related records.

Qualifications

- Secondary school diploma or equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Must be physically capable of performing required duties, including prolonged standing, bending, reaching and lifting, and able to work indoors and outdoors in climatic conditions.



EMPLOYMENT TRAINING PROGRAM

- Ability to lift materials and equipment (up to 44 lbs. or 20 kg).
- Ability to stand and walk for full eight (8) hour shift.
- Ability to push/pull carts and equipment (up to 44 lbs. or 20 kg).
- Knowledge of cleaning principles, practices and procedures.
- Demonstrated ability in the safe operation of related janitorial equipment (i.e. broom, mop, vacuum, cleaning products and wearing PPE).
- A proven ability to communicate in a courteous and tactful manner with a commitment to customer service.
- Ability to accurately follow verbal and written instructions.
- Must be familiar with WHMIS and the Occupational Health and Safety Act and Regulations that apply to this work, or attend training to become familiar.
- Ability and willingness to work days, evenings, overnights, weekends including holidays as required.
 - A commitment to work up to and including September 2, 2024 (Labour Day) as required.
- Some positions require a valid Ontario 'G' Driver's License in good standing (less than 3 demerit points).
 - Exhibition Place will obtain consent and arrange for Ministry of Transportation Driver's Abstract.
 - Successful candidates hired to drive must attend paid mandatory driver training during the month of July, 2024.
- Good work record including reliable attendance and punctuality.
- All successful applicants will be required to attend paid mandatory orientation during the month of July, 2024.

Application Process:

The first step in the recruitment process is for interested candidates to apply to the role with Jake's House, by emailing your resume to jobs@jakeshouse.ca, with the title of the job in the subject line. Applicants will be shortlisted for participation in the next step based on a review of each applicant assessing the likelihood of fit for the roles for which we are recruiting.
